TRAINING OVERVIEW

This course is designed to meet the essential requirements of safe working procedures on pressure systems required by the Pressure Systems Safety Regulations 2000 Provision, Work Equipment Regulations 1998, Safety Rules and Procedures for Work on Pressure Systems, and the Rules and Procedures contained within JSP 375 Volume 3 Chapter 6.

This is suitable for qualified personnel who have been nominated for appointment as Authorised Person (Boilers & Pressure Systems) in healthcare & non-healthcare environments.

Learners will be provided key information on pressure systems containing relevant fluids, and to ensure that candidates have a thorough understanding of the Safe System of Work and associated Permit to Work procedures.

COURSE AIMS

- Provide delegates with detailed information on boiler and pressure systems
- Ensure delegates have a thorough understanding of the Safe System of Work and associated Permit to Work procedures
- Leave with a certificate and the confidence to conduct their role as an authorised person
