TRAINING OVERVIEW

This course is designed to give you confidence and knowledge when working in Confined Spaces. It aims to help you recognise foreseeable risks, understand regulations and legislation, and have hands on experience with the specialist equipment used for Confined Space entry. This expanded course also covers high risk confined spaces.

COURSE AIMS

- To recognise confined spaces, understand regulations and the requirement for risk assessing, permits and method statement.
- How to inspect, put together and wear self-contained breather apparatus (SCBA)
- How to prepare for a high risk environment
- Know the difficulties of wearing SCBA
- Know how to select the correct equipment for the job
- How to inspect and use specialist equipment
- Up-to-date knowledge and practical knowledge for safe working in confined spaces
- Complete a practical exercise using specialist equipment (breathing air escape sets) that maybe required for confined space entry.
- This expanded course also provides learners with the skills and confidence to work safely in High Risk confined spaces by implementing relevant control measures.
- This course also includes additional top person duties.

2-day course classroom based commencing at 10:00 hours, ending at no later than 16:30 hours, with a 60-minute lunch break.

Team practical within a simulated confined space trailer unit. Assessment of learning will be a multiple choice delivered by paper.
