TRAINING OVERVIEW

This course is for staff who are involved in the operation and maintenance of swimming pools. The course aims to provide the candidates with the legal and technical requirements, health and safety aspects and management skills to operate the facility effectively.

Upon the successful completion of the course and assessment, delegates will be deemed to have a basic understanding of the core subject.

COURSE AIMS

- The medical aspects of managing pool systems
- A knowledge of the legal obligations and implications of managing pool systems
- Pollution of pool water in pool systems
- Waterborne pathogens
- Pool water circulation
- Plant design, operation and maintenance of pool systems
- Methods of water disinfection in pool systems
- Water quality & treatment – pH alkalinity etc.
- Water monitoring, sampling, the temperature in pool systems
- PWTAG (Pool Water Treatment Advisory Group)
- HSG 282 (HSE guidance on control of legionella and other infectious agents in Spa-Pool systems)

1-day course classroom based commencing at 10:00 hours, ending at no later than 16:30 hours, with a 60-minute lunch break. 3 hours live virtual classroom commencing at either 9:30-12:30 or 13:30-16:30.
