TRAINING OVERVIEW

This course is designed for delegates who undertake installation of water supply pipework (stop tap to stop tap).

Its aim is to provide the required training such that those that successfully complete this course and gain Approved Contractor Status can self-certify the installation of new supply pipes as complying with the Regulations/Byelaws, reducing the need for Water Companies to inspect (Approved Contractors will be subject to audit as a condition of membership).

COURSE AIMS

- Identify, interpret and comply with Water Regulations
- Identify non-compliances
- Have sufficient knowledge to pass the Groundworker Water Regulations assessment
- If successful, apply to become an approved member of a recognised scheme (i.e. Approved Contractor)
- The Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations / byelaws set out the installation requirements for plumbing systems.
- The Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999
- The Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations (Northern Ireland)
- The Water Supply (Water Fittings) (Scotland) Byelaws 2014

WHAT CERTIFICATION WILL YOU ACHIEVE?

Successful candidates will achieve a City and Guilds Accredited Certificate in Ground Workers: Water Regulations Training. Every 3 years the certificate should be refreshed.

HOW IS THIS COURSE DELIVERED?

Learning will be delivered in a classroom environment in the form of trainer explanation, group discussions, videos, practical classroom exercises and will be broken up with breakout sessions. Assessment of learning will be a multiple choice delivered by paper.
