TRAINING OVERVIEW

This course is designed for those involved in controlling the risk of legionella bacteria, Pseudomonas Aeruginosa, Mycobacteria, and other microorganisms in healthcare hot & cold-water systems that pose a reasonably foreseeable risk. They may maintenance staff, housekeepers and admin staff.

COURSE AIMS

This training programme will help to develop the skill and underpinning knowledge for effective hot and cold water system control in health care buildings. This course will cover Parts A-C in Healthcare Technical Memorandum 04-01: Safe Water in Healthcare premises and the D08 supplement for Thermostatic Mixing Valves.

DURATION

1-day course classroom based commencing at 10:00 hours, ending at no later than 16:30 hours, with a 60-minute lunch break. 3.5 hours live virtual classroom commencing at either 9:30 - 13:00 or 13:00 - 16:30.
